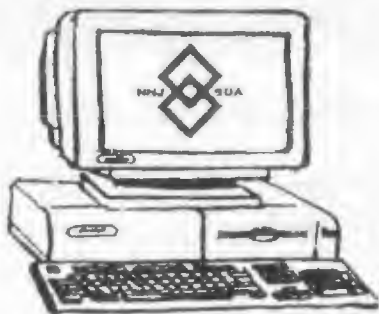

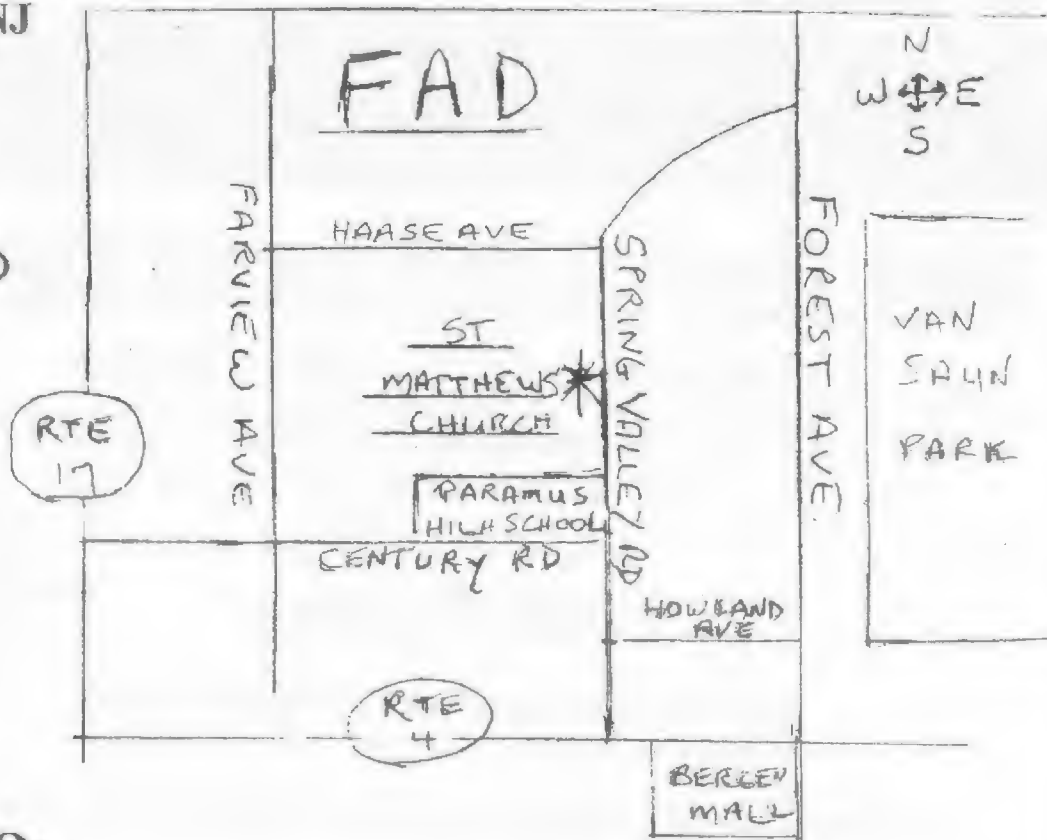

 - a. National Square Dance Month – September
 - b. Sufficient space for each club to fill in its own class or open house information.
4. **The subject matter must not be localized to any one geographical area.**
5. **Judging will be the responsibility and honor of the NNJSDA Executive Board at its March 2005 meeting.**
6. **All entries, including the winning poster, will become the property of the NNJSDA, and at its discretion be reprinted to promote square dancing in New Jersey, New York, and Pennsylvania. It may also be displayed at National and State Square Dance Conventions.**
7. **The winning poster will be featured on the cover of the Fall Issue of *Grand Square*.**

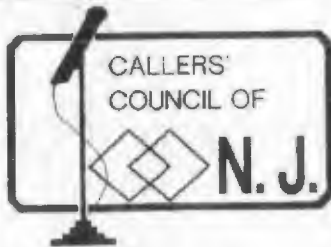

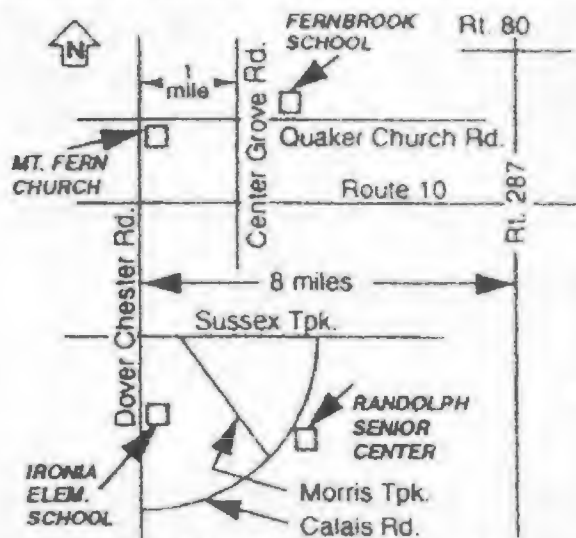

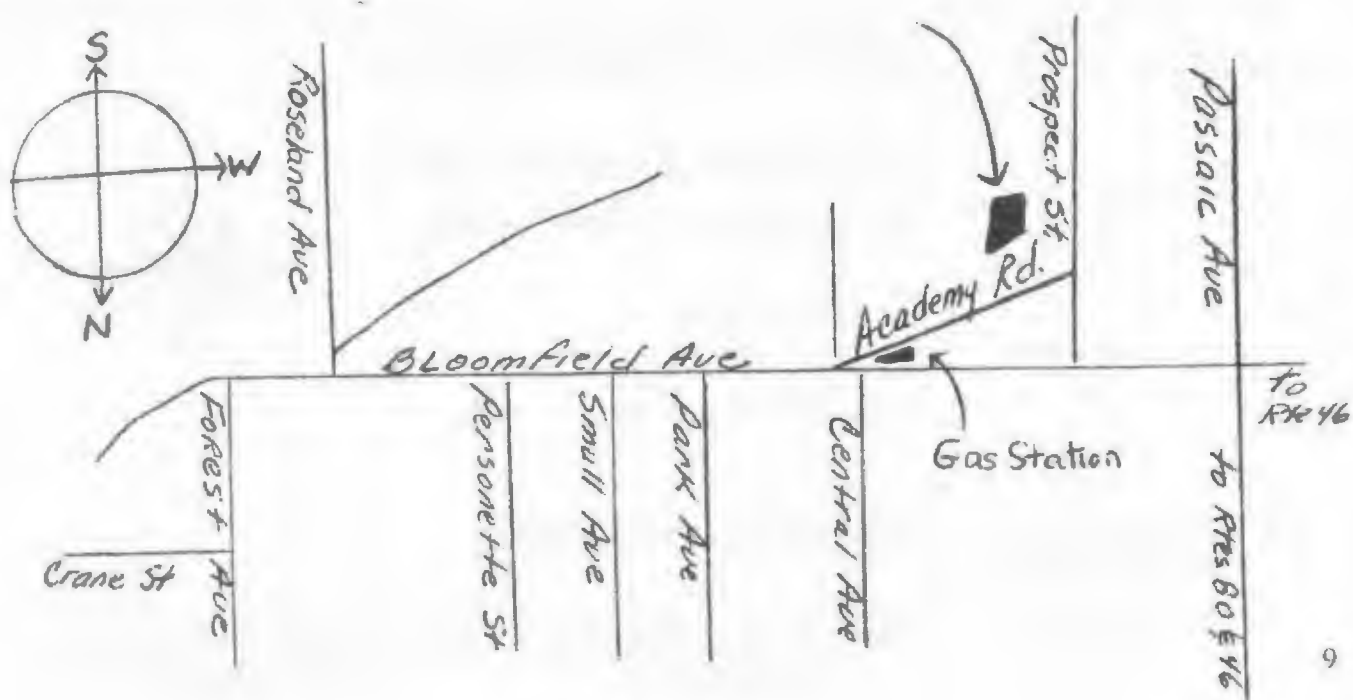

Dear NNJSDA Board, former Board members, and Club Presidents/Officers,

We had a good time at the Mini-Festival. Nice cast of characters! We appreciate having all the callers rotate through all the halls, a policy to keep.

However, no good deed [Editors: having students attend] goes unpunished. Please offer the Mainstream constituency a plan to soothe our (justifiably) ruffled feathers. We were all forced to dance pre-Basic to a national caller in a hall clearly posted as MS! At the following Belles & Beaux dance, several MS dancers made it known to us that they had had no alternative, and they were ticked off about it. In their words, imagine paying full price for the Mini-Fest and not being able to hear but 15 calls - over and over! And also imagine no pre-warning about it to anyone (except, of course, to the one club who brought its students). As second VP for B&B, Richard was upset that he had no chance to invite our students for a free dance experience.

We are not ones to expound on a problem without suggestions for a solution. Several thoughts come to mind. For future Mini-Fests, having a Basic hall might be a viable alternative if (1) all clubs know about it ahead of time, and they have agreed to the idea at a Delegates' Meeting; (2) the teachers know about it and can get their students up to a certain level which could then be communicated to the callers; (3) the Basic tips are every third tip so the MS dancers get some good dancing in; (4) the students pay a nominal pro-rated fee; (5) the callers make each Basic tip a real tip, and not a class - if five squares are making it through the calls and one is breaking down, don't stop five squares for one; and (6) the callers are warned ahead of time and can make it interesting.

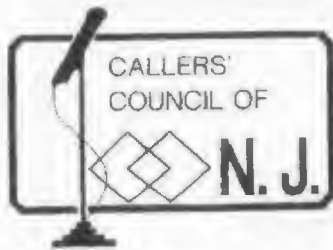
Two joyous events marked the Fall season for Lakelanders. On October 21, member Alice Goodell and Michael Winnick were married. We wish them well in their life together.

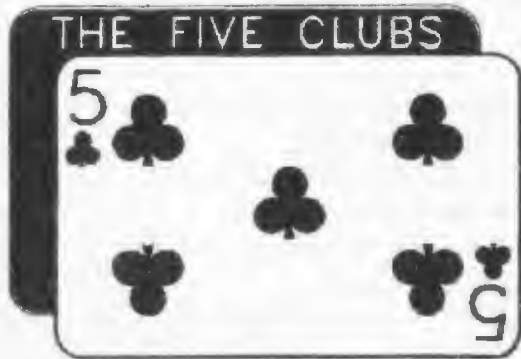

DIRECTIONS TO FLORENCE M. BURD (FMB) SCHOOL

FROM THE EAST: Take Route 80 West to Exit 34B (Route 15 North). Go about 10.6 miles to the second Sparta exit. Route 517 South (the first is the business district exit). Turn left onto 517 South. Go straight at second light (Shell Station on right). After about 1 mile Route 517 turns left; go straight (Route 616 West) for approximately 2 miles to the next light. Go straight through the light for about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE WEST: Take Route 80 East to Exit 19. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 517 North. Route 517 bears right at the blinker light 2.5 miles from route 80. Stay on Route 517 North for another 4 miles until you get to the junction of Route 206 in Andover. Turn left onto Route 206 North. Proceed about one mile to the Exxon station on the right. Turn right onto Limecrest Road (Route 669) and follow for 3.7 miles to the next light. Turn left onto Newton-Sparta Road and go about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Either come north on Route 287, get on Route 80 West and follow "FROM THE EAST" directions or come north on Route 206, get on Route 80 West for a very short distance, take exit 25 (Route 206 North). From here, go 6.5 miles to the Exxon Station in Andover on the right, turn right onto Limecrest Road (Route 669) and follow for 3.7 miles to the next light. Turn left onto Newton-Sparta Road and go about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

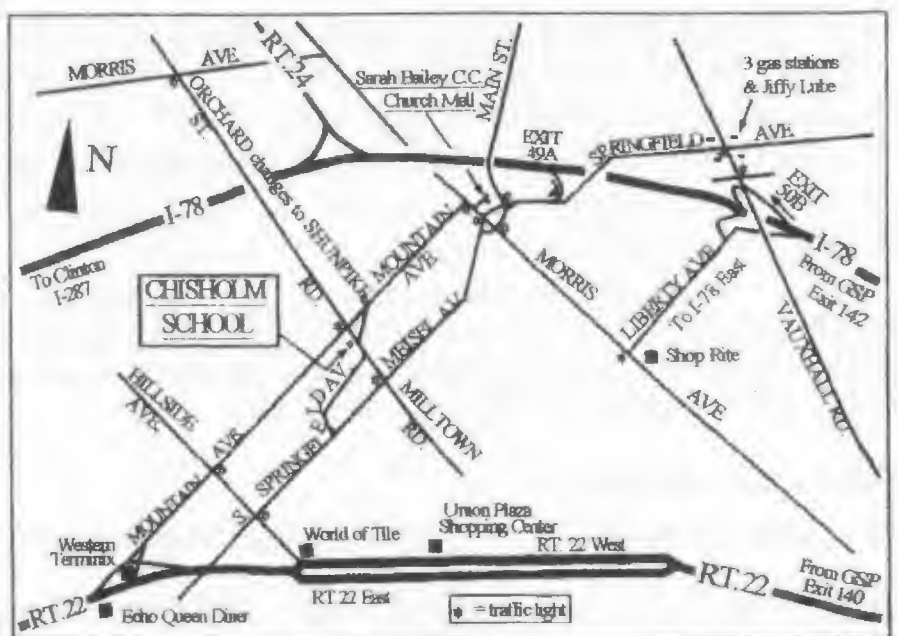

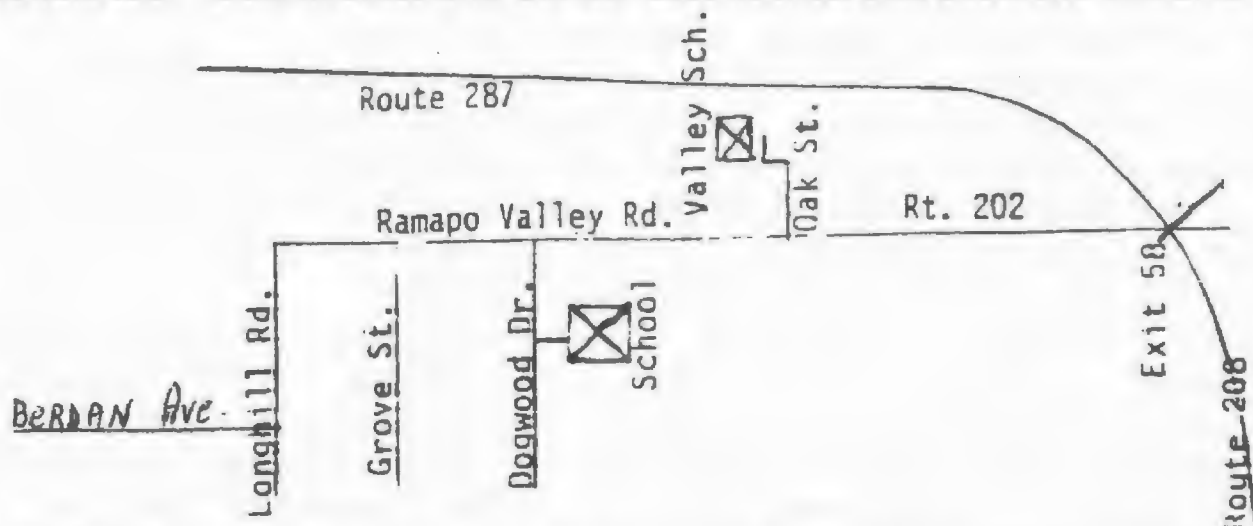

What is the Square Dance Council of New Jersey?

It is presently comprised of the Callers Council of New Jersey, the Central New Jersey Square Dance Association, the Federation of Delaware Valley Square and Round Dancers, the Northern New Jersey Round Dance Leaders Council, and the Northern New Jersey Square Dancers Association. The now inactive Dance Leaders of the Delaware Valley and Bucks-Trenton/Penn-Jersey District of the FDVSD were former members.

The semi-annual meetings are held to share information on upcoming events and discuss matters pertinent to the various organizations. The Council is entitled to send four delegates and four alternates to the United Square Dancers of America (USDA) annual meeting held at the National Square Dance Convention. The Council's delegates are the voice of New Jersey area dancers regarding the operation of the USDA. The SDCNJ recently received \$400 as a rebate from the credit card program sponsored by the USDA.

The Council handles the sale of the New Jersey square dance license plates. Contact Rich Delgado at 609-530-0849 for more information on the plates. The SDCNJ also owns a supply of water jugs, turntables, and walkie/talkies which may be loaned to any club in the NNJSDA. In years past, the Council has sponsored the New Jersey State Conventions and a family day at Great Adventure. In addition, the Council sponsored the "Docking Dance" in support of the 49th National Square Dance Convention held in Baltimore; we were able to provide a \$5,000 check as seed money.

The elected officers are Roy and Betsy Gotta (Chairmen), Jim Novak (Treasurer), and Richard Delgado (Secretary); the post of Vice Chairperson is still vacant.

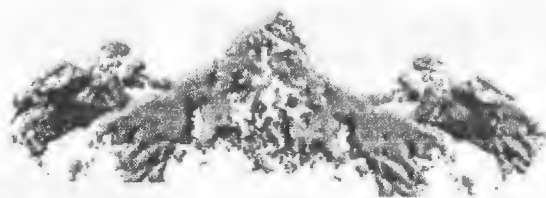



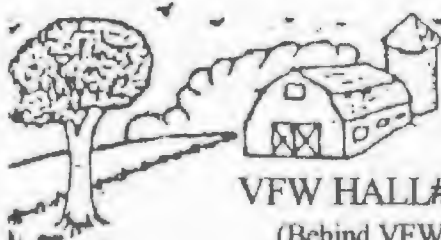
