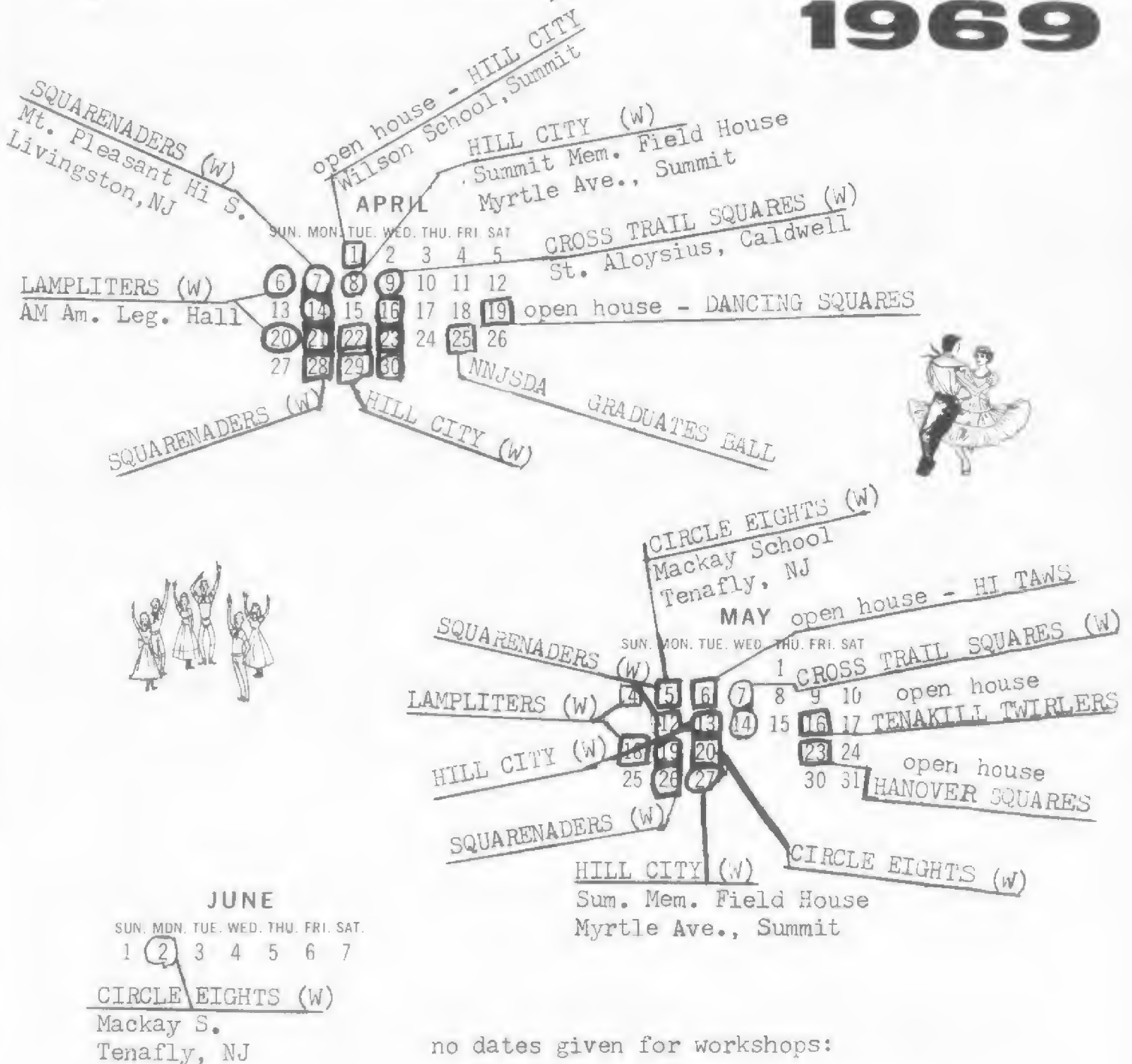

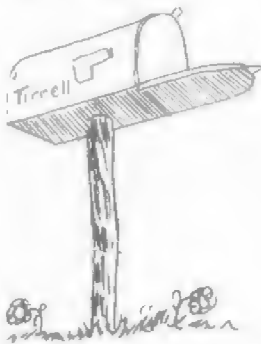
FROM THE DESK OF ... Ray & Pam Zeliff, presidents NNJSDA

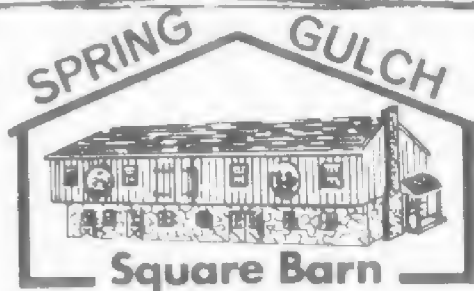
