(a) From Rts. 10 & 46, and Rt. 80 EAST - take Rt. 287 NORTH to Exit # 47, Rt. 202, Montville. Stay in left lane on exit ramp. Turn Left at the light at end of exit ramp onto Rt. 202 North. Proceed as in (b) below.

(b) **Senior House** is only 1/10 mile on your left. On the left you will pass an office bldg., then pass the white exterior of the Senior House. Turn left into the driveway and left to parking in front of the Senior House. The **Senior House** is a white building across the parking lot from the Police Station on Rt. 202 South. If you get to the Exxon station on Rt. 202, you have gone too far.

(c) From Rt. 80 WEST - immediately after passing exit for Rt. 46 West/Parsippany get into the right lane. Follow signs for Rt. 287 onto the service road that runs parallel to Rt. 80 staying in the right lane. At end of service road follow the right lane around to the right and then left onto Rt. 287 North (DO NOT TAKE - left lane of ramp goes to 287 South, and far right lane goes to Smith Rd.) Once on Rt. 287 NORTH proceed as in (a) & (b) above.

(d) From Rt. 23 - take Rt. 287 SOUTH to Exit # 47, Rt. 202, Montville. Turn Right at the light at end of exit ramp onto Rt. 202 North. Go straight through the next light. Proceed as in (b) above.

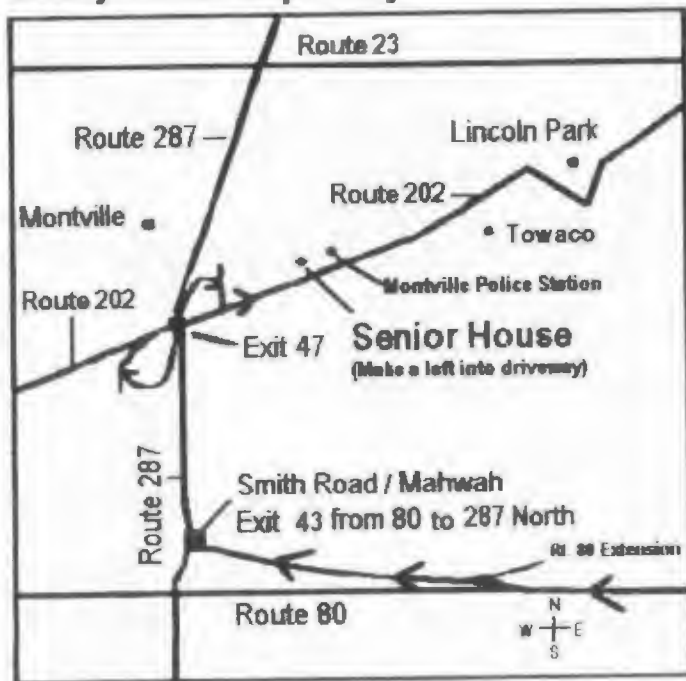

DIRECTIONS TO FLORENCE M. BURD (FMB) SCHOOL

FROM THE EAST: Take Route 80 West to Exit 34B (Route 15 North). Go about 10.6 miles to the second Sparta exit. Route 517 South (the first is the business district exit). Turn left onto 517 South. Go straight at second light (Shell Station on right). After about 1 mile Route 517 turns left; go straight (Route 616 West) for approximately 2 miles to the next light. Go straight through the light for about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE WEST: Take Route 80 East to Exit 19. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 517 North. Route 517 bears right at the blinker light 2.5 miles from route 80. Stay on Route 517 North for another 4 miles until you get to the junction of Route 206 in Andover. Turn left onto Route 206 North. Proceed about one mile to the Exxon station on the right. Turn right onto Limecrest Road (Route 669) and follow for 3.7 miles to the next light. Turn left onto Newton-Sparta Road and go about 1/2 mile to Florence M. Burd School on the right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Either come north on Route 287, get on Route 80 West and follow "FROM THE EAST" directions or come north on Route 206, get on Route 80 West for a very short distance, take exit 25 (Route 206 North). From here, go 6.5 miles to the Exxon Station in Andover on the right, turn right onto Limecrest Road
