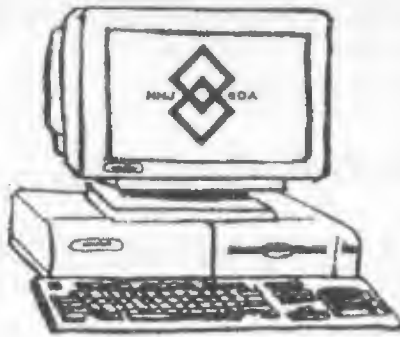

### Donna Poyer and Mike Szekula



These two faces are a familiar sight to anyone who attends NNJSDA dances. But it's a wonder that Donna Poyer and Mike Szekula ever find time to actually dance, given all the hard work they do behind the scenes to keep the Association and their own club alive and well. They currently serve as presidents of the NNJSDA.

Mike spent his childhood in Marcella (Rockaway Township), close to Egbert's Lake where old-fashioned style square dances were held on Saturday nights with a four-piece band. Although he knew about square dancing from the age of 13, he did not take lessons until his former wife suggested doing so many

years later. They joined Lakeland Squares in 1976, and later the Kittatinny Rangers.

Donna lived in Lyndhurst before her family moved to the Hackettstown area. She enjoyed Eastern style square dances at the Mountain Lake Casino with her boyfriend. They married, but she became a widow at a young age with full responsibility for raising two sons and working to support the family. When a friend suggested taking square dance lessons, she relished the chance to "escape reality" for the 2 ½-hour classes. She joined the Kittatinny Rangers in 1988 and was immediately appointed class coordinator. Since then, she has always held at least one office in the club, and Mike has held a number of positions as well. They served as club presidents last season.

Donna and Mike especially enjoy the national conventions, experiences they share with good friends from around the country. The California convention was particularly memorable as they were joined by friends from South Carolina, Texas, and China. The group of eight drove down the coast and did "touristy" things for a week, and then went to Disneyland to march down Main Street and dance!

## Remembering Hal Margo Five Clubs

We doubt that there are very many dancers in the NNJSDA who haven't been touched and enriched by the presence of Hal Margo.

Along with his wife Florence, Hal served square dancing in every capacity imaginable from club president, to historian, to editor, to guardian angel and gadfly! Hal and Florence were active in Bee Sharps and Y Squares for many years and were instrumental in the creation of the Five Clubs, serving as chairpersons until last year. Hal and Florence produced and distributed a newsletter for Y Squares that is arguably the best newsletter in New Jersey square dancing. Hal would walk around during the Y Squares and Five Clubs dances, personally handing out the newsletter to each person, not merely to save on postage, but also to wish us well and to connect with each dancer. Hal was the person you could always count on to take a new dancer under his wing, encouraging the discouraged, even when he himself was not feeling well enough to dance.

Hal Margo was a graduate of Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and a licensed professional engineer who worked many years for Exxon. Hal and Florence recently celebrated their 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary with a series of family parties and a free square dance at Y Squares, inviting everyone to share their joy.

Most of all, Hal Margo was a gentleman and a friend – a friend to square dancing and a friend to all who knew him. Our sympathy goes out to Florence and their children. Square dancing has lost one of its best friends.

recording equipment and how to develop, direct, and record TV shows. Then they recruited a caller, a cuer, and many dancers from all over Minnesota to come and square and round dance in front of the cameras. Next, they canvassed the public access stations in Minnesota to get them to carry the series. To date, they have created 37 shows which are airing on 62 public access cable stations in Minnesota, Wisconsin, North Dakota, South Dakota, Iowa, Alaska, Hawaii, and now New Jersey. The shows they created exemplify the best of square dancing, showing a typical square dance with squares and rounds and interesting interviews between the dancing. Some shows have live music, some have themes, and most shows have multiple callers and cuers. Dick Rueter and Ray Balanger, the show's regular caller and cuer, each has over 30 years of dancing experience, and they feel comfortable bantering with the dancers and one another during the dances. The show's producers, Dee and Ken Scott, have truly created a square dance series of hour-long, hand-clapping, toe-tapping, foot-stomping good times.

Earlier this year officers of both the NNJSDA and the Square Dance Council of New Jersey viewed some tapes of existing shows. They offered their support for airing the shows in New Jersey and the New York metropolitan area provided that NJ/NY viewers had a way to find out more information about dancing in NJ/NY and not just Minnesota. Thus a phone number and a Square Dance Council of New Jersey website were established, and each show aired in our area now flashes on the screen these contacts and other square dance information that might be of interest to prospective or new dancers.

Currently the show is airing on Mondays (5:30-6:30) and Thursdays (6:30-7:30) in areas served by Piscataway Community Television (channel 22), on Sundays (10:00pm-11:00pm) and Wednesdays (9:00am-10:00am) in areas serviced by Patriot Media (channel 8), and it is planned to have it air once a month in Livingston starting in August.

### Mainstream can be taught in One Weekend!

Rather than insisting on a 28-week course for teaching mainstream, an alternative approach that proved successful was described in "CALLERLAB Viewpoints" by Dick Mazziotti, which appeared in the December 2004 issue of *American Square Dance*. The following is excerpted from that article.

A CALLERLAB member, Steve Jacques offered to put on a weekend mainstream course for free. He started with a Friday evening session of 25 calls. Much of Saturday was taught in mini-squares. The balance of the calls were introduced Sunday morning. Three full squares of new dancers were brought on board in three days.

Here are some suggestions from Steve:

1. You need somebody who is very organized, committed, and willing to work hard to make it a success.
2. Look for a relatively inexpensive hall rental that makes it easy to offer the weekend for a reasonable price.
3. Door prizes for the new dancers, a 50-50 raffle and serving lunch on Saturday add to the fun.
4. Lots of angels help to fill the hall, make the new dancers feel less conspicuous, and speed the learning process.
5. The caller should use a variety of music, have a good sense of humor, lots of patience, and be willing to choreograph on the fly.
6. Plus clubs must agree not to push dancers to learn Plus.

One final suggestion is that the Sunday session should be extended to 6 P.M. The additional four hours of dancing will allow more dancing time when calls are being reviewed.
